

Southern Belle
Finished block measures 6 in. high and 6 in. wide

Fabric strips are 44 in. long


Cut 1 - $37 / 8$ in. wide strip

Cut 2 triangles from 1 square


Cut 1 - $37 / 8$ in. wide strip
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Cut 1 - $41 / 4$ in. wide strip
Cut 4 triangles from 1 square


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Cut 4 triangles from 1 square

Use $1 / 4$ " seam allowance throughout

1) Cut $A$ along the diagonal in half. Repeat with $B$

2) Cut C along both diagonals to make 4 small triangles. Repeat with D.

3) Place $C$ and $D$, right sides facing together. Make sure the corner angle $90^{\circ}$ angle, is to your right as in the picture below. Sew from the corner angle down. Press open. The coloured fabric, D, should be on the right hand side when the pointed tip of the triangle is pointing down and the long edge is pointing up as in picture below. Trim off dog ears. This will be Unit A.

4) Using $A$ and $B$ and the Unit $A$, arrange the pieces as shown and sew on the long diagonal. This will make 4 squares comprising 2 pieces quarter triangle and 1 piece half triangle. Press and trim off dog ears.

5) Join the squares in pairs as shown below to form 2 strips. Press. Join the 2 strips to complete the block.
