## Face Mask

Basic Instructions (no pictures and assumes knowledge of basic sewing techniques)

## Requirements:

Fabric - $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ ( ${ }^{\prime \prime}(2)$ ( Use fabric with at least 180 count cotton fabric or batik)
Interfacing - $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times \mathbf{8 " \prime}^{\prime \prime}(1)$
Ties - At least 2" $\mathbf{x ~ 3 6 " ~}$ long (2)
Sewing implements $-1 / 4$ " seam allowance used unless otherwise specified.
Instructions

1) Iron interfacing on wrong side of 1 piece of fabric
2) With right sides facing, sew fabric pieces together leaving 3 " opening for turning.
3) Turn fabric piece to right side and press.
4) On both short sides, make $61^{\prime \prime}$ marks along the sides.
5) Fold marks:
a. 1 to 2
b. 3 to 4
c. 5 to 6

Pin down and sew $1 / \mathbf{z}^{\prime \prime}$ around the edge of the fabric. (This will secure the folds and close the turn opening)
6) Prepare ties:
a. Fold ties in half lengthwise, press. Open up and fold a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ to the the centreline from both sides. Then fold in half lengthwise again.
7) Find the centre of each tie and the centre of the mask body. Align the centres and sew ties to each side.
8) Enjoy your face mask.
